2021 REFLECTION

Revive celebrated its fifth anniversary on April 8, 2021, while the COVID-19 pandemic entered its second year. This is yet another feat that many nonprofit service providers never achieve!

Throughout this year, our priority has remained on keeping our clients, staff, and the community safe and healthy. Despite the ongoing challenges we all faced, 2021 was a tremendous year of growth for Revive. Finance, Workforce Development (HR), Medical, Marketing, Technology, and the Facilities departments were targeted for growth in administrative staffing ratios, materials and equipment, security measures, and better utilization of current resources. We also achieved a three-year certification through the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM), which was crucial to continue as a Medicaid reimbursable treatment program. Our team spent months learning the standards and developing numerous policies and procedures to meet the certification requirements. The Adam Lowe Center (ALC) is now certified as a 3.5 Level of Care facility for residential services.

Our mission is simple. We are a beautiful people-centered, life giving addiction treatment center in Central KY, where the overdose mortality rate has increased over 50%. Through our dynamic recovery programs serving both male and female clients, we will continue to create a safe and welcoming environment where our clients can find help, freedom, and purpose for their lives.

First I must say, "Praise and Glory be to God, without Him I am nothing." I had been to four treatment facilities before Revive. None of them kept me sober and clean. It wasn't until I got to Revive that I realized that the twelve steps wouldn't work for me, and God alone wouldn't work for me. I had to have both.

After being charged and released from Boyle County, and learning about Revive, I started to walk to meet my family. A guy pulls up in a minivan and asks me if I need a ride. He told me he would have taken me all the way, but he was on his way to work.

I asked where he worked, and he said Revive. This blew my mind. I said I was trying to get in. He looked me in the

eyes and asked me if I wanted to go. I said "right now?" He said yes.

I haven't looked back since. It's amazing to see how God made all those things happen in that order so I could be right where I needed to be, to run into my friend who got me into Revive. Fun fact: when I decided to give my life to the Lord, the same friend baptized me.

My home is restored and I teach my children about God's love, grace, and mercy. I had been chasing those things for years in the wrong way and never got them. But God saw fit to give me all of those things in a matter of months the moment I started to follow Him and do His will and not mine. He just keeps on hitting me with blessing after blessing.

APRIL CRANE, MEDICAL


My name is April and I am a grateful believer in Jesus Christ! I spent nearly 20 years of my life in active addiction. Five years and eight months ago, I found myself at my lowest — my bottom.

I was working as a nurse at the Fayette County Detention Center and was taking care of a lot of people who were just like me, but they weren't hiding behind a career. This really compounded my self-loathing and made me feel like the biggest hypocrite ever. I lied to my family and friends and isolated myself from them. I cared for my patients while impaired. I hated myself and who I had become. I was eventually fired from my job, because I couldn't hide my addiction any longer.

I became suicidal and knew I had to get help or I was going to die. I went to a treatment facility much like Revive, but specifically for women. It was faith-based, and it was there that I was re-introduced to the love of Jesus!

On Nov. 18, 2016, I entered the Kentucky Alternative Recovery Effort (KARE) program for nurses. This is a five-year monitoring program that promotes rehabilitation and provides accountability. I had to check in daily for random drug testing, complete monthly reports and participate in employer and counseling evaluations quarterly. I am so grateful for this program, as it allowed me to continue in the field of nursing while also protecting the public from harm.

I am also very grateful for Revive for hiring me a little over two years ago with full knowledge of my participation in the KARE program and its requirements. I completed the program in November and on May 30, I will celebrate six years of sobriety. I am also free from any mood/mind-altering substances. Jesus is my remedy! I am a new creation in Christ!
